

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE CITY OF GREENFIELD BOARD OF CANVASSERS HELD AT THE GREENFIELD CITY HALL ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2024

The City Clerk and two citizens of the City of Greenfield, appointed by the City Clerk, met as the Board of Canvassers at the Greenfield City Hall on Monday, November 11, 2024. The purpose of the meeting was to review status of provisional ballots, process one provisional ballot cast in the Presidential & General Election on November 5, 2024, and to count four ballots that were not included in the election results election night, and to declare the results thereof in accordance with Section 7.53 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The meeting was called to order by City Clerk Jennifer Goergen at 9:01 a.m.

The City Clerk reported that six provisional ballots were issued citywide during the November 5, 2024 Presidential & General Election, as follows: two in Ward 4, two in Ward 11, one in Ward 19, and one in Ward 24. Only one voter returned to the City Clerk's office to provide the missing information to have their ballot counted, which was Provisional Voter #2 in Ward 11 who was unable or unwilling to provide acceptable proof of identification at the polls. The voter came in to the City Clerk's office and provided acceptable POI on November 8, 2024 at 2:51 p.m. Since the voter provided the necessary information, the ballot could be processed by the Board of Canvassers.

The Board of Canvassers opened the ballot bag, seal no. 182027, examined the Provisional Ballot Certificate Envelope, which was completed properly, opened the ballot and tallied the votes. The EI-106P Statement of the Municipal Board of Canvassers was completed. The ballot was resealed in ballot bag with seal no. 182266.

The Board of Canvassers was asked to process two absentee ballots (one for Ward 1 and one for Ward 2) that were hand delivered to the City Clerk's office prior to the close of polls on November 5, 2024 and logged into WisVote at that time. Staff noticed after the polls were closed and totals were run that these ballots had not been sent out to be delivered to the polls for counting and should have been. The Board of Canvassers accepted these ballots, opened them, and tallied the votes for Ward 1 and Ward 2.

A Chief Inspector for Ward 3 explained on the Ward 3 Inspectors' Statement that a Ward 3 ballot that was checked into Badger Book for processing but had not been put through the DS200 voting machine to be counted because election results had already been printed and the DS200 voting machine for Ward 3 was closed down. The Ward 3 ballot was kept with the Inspectors' Statement materials for consideration by the Board of Canvassers. The Board of Canvassers tallied the votes for this Ward 3 ballot.

A Chief Inspector for Ward 4 explained that a Ward 4 ballot was in with a stack of Ward 9 absentee ballots that were being processed through Ward 9's DS200 voting machine. Ward 9's DS200 would not accept the Ward 4 ballot, but Ward 4's DS200 voting machine had already printed the results tapes and been closed down for this election. Therefore, this Ward 4 ballot could not be counted through the machine at the polls. The Ward 4 ballot was kept with the Inspectors' Statement materials for consideration by the Board of Canvassers. The Board of Canvassers tallied the votes for this Ward 4 ballot.

We, the City Clerk and two citizens appointed by the City Clerk, Devan Gracyalny and Denise Collins, certify that we are the members of the Board of Canvassers for the City of Greenfield, Milwaukee County. We certify that the provisional ballot was processed by us and added to the election results for Ward 11 and that the results as canvassed by the Board of Canvassers as indicated are correct and true as compiled from the returns made to the City of Greenfield City Clerk.
