

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT THE GREENFIELD CITY HALL ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 30, 2025

A. Call to Order & Roll Call

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Neitzke at 6:00 PM.

B. New Business

1. Discussion and possible action to approve a contract for services with Community Security Solutions. (Neitzke)

Mayor Neitzke stated that there were agenda items for Council President and committee assignments, but he wanted those to be at a regularly scheduled meeting.

Motion by Alderperson Kastner, seconded by Alderperson Bailey to approve. On a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

2. Discussion and decision to approve a Facility Use Agreement with Adoration Lutheran Church to provide a polling location for 2026-2027 elections. (Goergen)

Motion by Alderperson Kastner, seconded by Alderperson Saryan to approve. On a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

3. Approve the transfer of \$55,000 from the general fund account 010-1910-530.5900 to a capital equipment project to upgrade light fixtures in the Public Works Building with LED fixtures. (Katz)

Mayor Neitzke said that Randy Esch, Department of Public Works Superintendent, was present. The LED fixtures have been gradually replaced throughout all the facilities. The savings at the Law Enforcement Center have been astronomical. The return on investment has been very good.

Motion by Alderperson Akers, seconded by Alderperson Drzewiecki to approve. On a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

4. Approval of mileage reimbursements in the amount of \$26.18. (Schafer)

Mayor Neitzke welcomed Channel 6 to Greenfield. Mountain Mike's had their grand opening and ribbon-cutting today and welcomed the business to Greenfield. June 7th is the official ribbon-cutting for The Turf skate park. They are feverishly working on the site. It is the second-largest skate park in the Midwest and will be the most challenging, historical, and modern skate park around with almost every obstacle there is.
