

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT THE GREENFIELD CITY HALL ON TUESDAY, JUNE 26, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Alderperson Linda Lubotsky at 6:15 p.m. Alderperson Lubotsky said she was presiding as chair, not as acting Mayor, and would be voting.

2. It was moved by Alderperson Akers, seconded by Alderperson Lubotsky, to go into closed session at 6:19 p.m. pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, Section 19.85(1)(b) & (f) for the following item:

- a. Application for license received to expire June 30, 2019. Note: The Police Department requested that the establishment related to item (1) below be placed on a separate list from those approved at previous Common Council meetings.

(1) Combination "Class A" Fermented Malt Beverage & Liquor License

On a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

3. It was moved by Alderperson Akers, seconded by Alderperson Bailey, to adjourn closed session and reconvene into open session at 6:26 p.m. On a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

4. Decision regarding application for Combination "Class A" Fermented Malt Beverage & Liquor License received to expire June 30, 2019 (approval of license should be *subject to the City of Greenfield ordinances regarding code compliance and payment of all delinquent taxes and charges*).

Alderperson Lubotsky said City Attorney Brian Sajdak could not be present tonight but he sent a letter outlining the results of his meeting with the owner of Arora Trading Inc. d/b/a Jens Beer & Liquor. The City Attorney wrote that the owner is taking this matter seriously, and a violation that occurred after the "last chance" meeting resulted from human error as opposed to deficiencies in policies and procedures. Accordingly, he wrote that he recommended renewal of the license with a caution that future violations will result in revocation proceedings.

Alderperson Lubotsky said this is the owner's last chance - if there are future violations that the license could be revoked. Alderperson Bailey said the license could be suspended or revoked if there are any further violations.

It was moved by Alderperson Bailey, seconded by Alderperson Lubotsky, to approve the 2018-2019 Combination "Class A" Fermented Malt Beverage & Liquor License, subject to the City of Greenfield ordinances regarding code compliance and payment of all delinquent taxes and charges, for Arora Trading
