5.	Greenfield Police Department Reports. (Chief Wentlandt). Captain Patrick is heading up a project to lower the number of aggressive coyotes in the City. Assistant Chief Schlecht is retiring on Friday, December 18 th . Pat Martin retired late last month. We have had a number of auto thefts, car jacking’s, retail thefts, and street robberies. We continue to see heroin/prescription opiate addiction in young people. A couple of programs are in the works to be rolled out in January to address this. In February we will host a heroin prescription opiate summit at Whitnall High School in conjunction with the Forward Thinking Group. Officer Triumph was sworn in today; leaving the department three officers short. Hoping to swear in two more in January.
