

MINUTES FROM THE GREENFIELD POLICE & FIRE COMMISSION MEETING HELD AT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER, Court Room – 5300 West Layton Avenue, Greenfield, on Monday, November 13, 2017 AT 6:00 P.M.

1.	Meeting called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Commissioner Cashmore, Chairperson.	Call to Order
2.	Pledge of Allegiance.

4.	Approval of the Police & Fire Commission Minutes for the July 25, 2017 meeting. Motion by Commissioner Springob, Seconded by Commissioner Brown to approve minutes on a unanimous roll call vote with Commissioner Clark abstaining.	
5.	Greenfield Fire Department Reports (Chief Cohn). So much has changed in Fire Department from six years ago when the chiefs were sworn in. Six years ago we had 12 paramedics and 30 EMTs, now we have 40 paramedics and 8 EMTs. Now every ambulance has a paramedic. All policies were updated last year. Technologies have been upgraded.	
6.	Greenfield Police Department Reports (Chief Wentlandt). Officer Karweik and Nemesh doing well. Two others are close to completing probation. One opening but applicant pool is low. May have to go to CSO's and send to academy.	
7.	Discussion on reports from Police and Fire Departments. Commissioner Clark asked for regular reports from both departments. Chief Wentlandt stated they haven't done any for about four years. Crimereports.com is a service the PD pays for and shows all reported calls for service. Also Facebook and Twitter have daily postings. Fire department also has a Facebook account and Pulse Point application that will show all calls.	
8.	Commission Election of Officers. Commissioner Springob made a motion to retain all those already in positions. Seconded by Commissioner Brown. Roll call vote unanimous.	
9.	New Business. Assembly Bill 606 may affect City of Greenfield.	
10.	Invoices. One from Childs \$1020, One from aurora \$668 for physical function fitness, \$347 from aurora. Motion by Commissioner Clark to pay., seconded by Commissioner DeGaro to approve. Unanimously approved.	
11.	New Items for Placement on Next Agenda. None	
12.	The next meeting of the Greenfield Police and Fire Commission shall be held when there are items that require a meeting.
