6. Discussion and decision to adopt an ordinance amending section 3.12 of the Municipal
Code relating to Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS) data – fee schedule

Atty. Pyzyk explained that this is recommended in order to update our fee schedule to be
consistent with the fees for the same data as charged by the Government Accountability
Board.

It was moved by Ald. Saryan, seconded by Ald. Bailey, to recommend the adoption of
this ordinance as presented, with regards to updating the fee schedule for reports
containing voter data. Motion carried unanimously.

7. Discussion/decision to repeal Section 3.12 (3) of the Municipal Code relating to taxicab,
limousine and taxicab driver fees

Atty. Pyzyk explained that since we no longer issue licenses to taxicabs, limousines and
taxicab drivers we need to remove this from the Municipal Code.

It was moved by Ald. Saryan, seconded by Ald. Lubotsky, to recommend [adoption of
an ordinance] repealing of Section 3.12 (3) of the Municipal Code relating to taxicab,
limousine and taxicab driver fees. Motion carried unanimously.

8. Discussion/decision to adopt an ordinance amending section 1.16 of the Municipal Code
relating to the Municipal Judge

Atty. Pyzyk stated that this is a correction since the Municipal Code references Wisconsin State Statute 19.01 (4)(c) , but the actual reference should be 19.01 (4)(f).

It was moved by Ald. Saryan, seconded by Ald. Bailey, to recommend [adoption of an ordinance] amending Section 1.16 of the Municipal Code to correct the reference to State Statute 19.01 (4)(f), relating to the Municipal Judge. Motion carried unanimously.

9. Discussion/decision to adopt an ordinance amending Section 13.07 of the Municipal Code relating to entertainment and amusement.

Atty. Pyzyk gave the background on this amendment, in which the requirement of the fee charged for an entertainment license will not apply in car shows without entertainment or food services.

It was moved by Ald. Saryan, seconded by Ald. Bailey, to adopt an ordinance amending section 13.07 (3) of the Municipal Code as follows: *Exclusions: The fee prescribed in Section 13.07 (3) of the Greenfield Municipal Code shall not apply to car shows where no entertainment or food services is provided, or to events sponsored by a recognized 501c charitable organization.* Motion carried unanimously.
